### General rules

- All public and private entities
- Profit-oriented organisations: limited access
- International organisations
  
- Justice: All MS, except DK and UK
- REC: All MS + Iceland and Liechtenstein for some calls

**BUT** consult each call for the specific rules!

⇒ To be published in the period July – September 2015

- JUST/2015/JACC/AG/PROC: (transnational projects)  
to enhance the rights of **suspected or accused of crime**
- JUST/2015/JTRA/AG/EJTR: (transnational projects)  
to promote the **quality of national justice systems**
- JUST/2015/JTRA/AG/EJTR: (transnational projects)  
to support European **judicial training**
- Call of DG COMP: (transnational or national projects)  
to support **training of national judges on EU competition law**

# I.d. The 2015 Calls for proposals (2)

## Justice Programme – Action Grants

⇒ To be published in the period October – December 2015

- JUST/2015/JCOO/AG/CIVI: (transnational or national projects) to support **judicial cooperation in civil matters**
- JUST/2015/JCOO/AG/CRIM: (transnational projects) to support **judicial cooperation in criminal matters**

to promote **Roma integration activities (Roma platforms)**
- JUST/2015/RDAP/AG/0116: (restricted to 116000 hotline operators)  
to support **the 116000 hotlines for missing children**
- JUST/2015/RRAC/AG: (transnational projects)  
to prevent and combat **racism**
- JUST/2015/RDAP/AG/SEXV: (transnational projects)  
to combat **sexual harassment and sexual violence against women/girls**

# I.d. The 2015 Calls for proposals (4)

## REC – Action Grants

⇒ To be published in the period October – December 2015

- JUST/2015/RDAP/AG/VICT: (transnational projects)  
to protect and support **victims of violence**
- JUST/2015/RDAP/AG: (transnational or national projects)  
**Violence against women/children:** to promote **multi-agency & multi-disciplinary cooperation** and to **tackle underreporting**
- JUST/2015/RDAP/AG/CORP: (transnational projects)  
to combat **corporal punishment**
- JUST/2015/RCHI/AG/PROF: (transnational projects)  
to build **capacity of professionals in the area of the rights of the child**

## REC – Action Grants

⇒ To be published in the period October – December 2015

- JUST/2015/RDIS/AG/DISC: (transnational or national projects) to support projects on **non-discrimination** and **Roma integration**
- JUST/2015/RGEN/AG/GEND: (transnational projects) to promoted good practices on **gender roles** and to overcome **gender stereotypes**

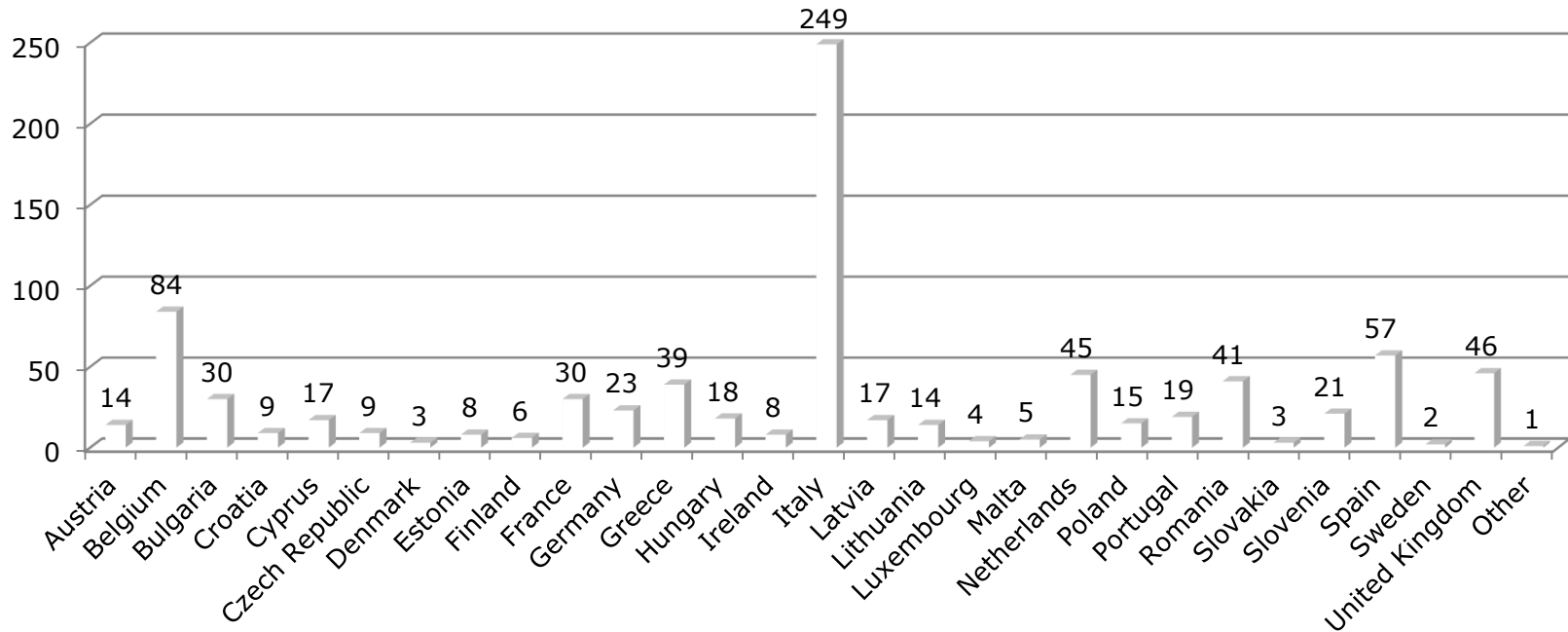
# Statistics on Cyprus' participation 2014

## Total applications Justice & REC



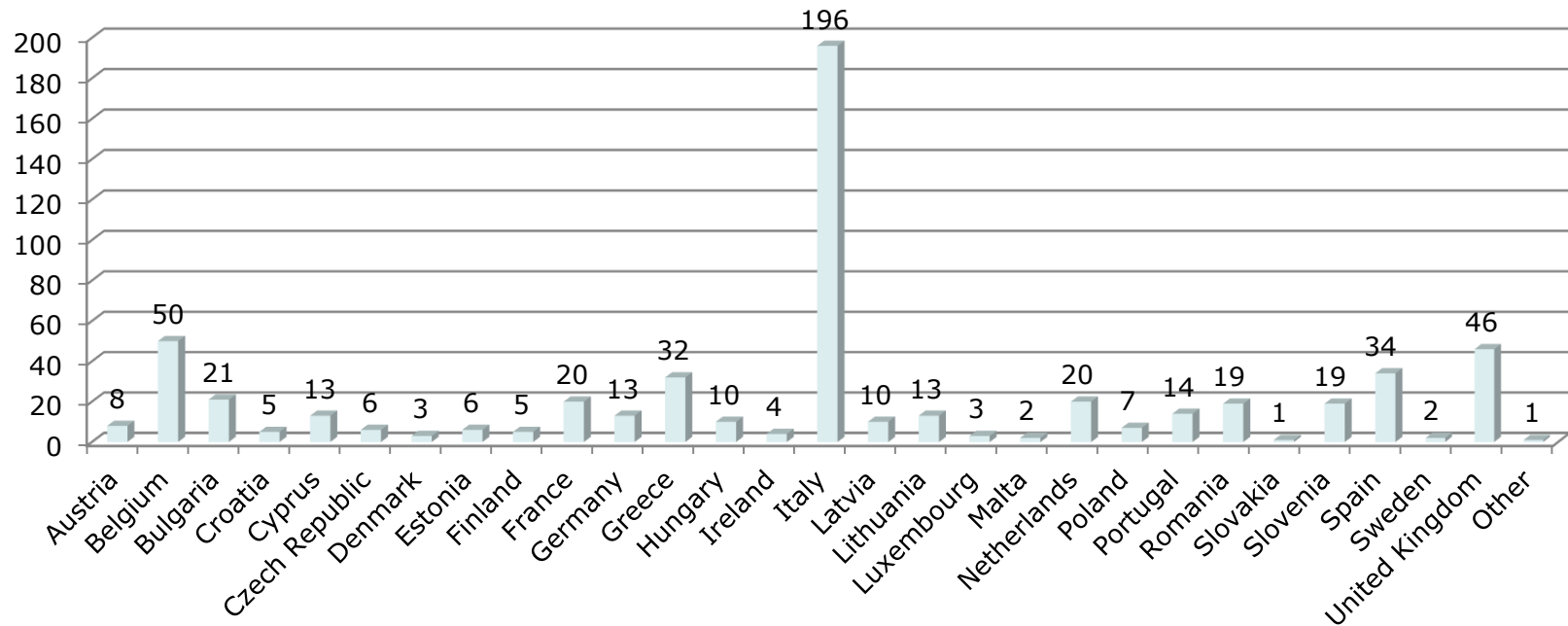
# Statistics on Cyprus' participation 2014

## Total applications REC



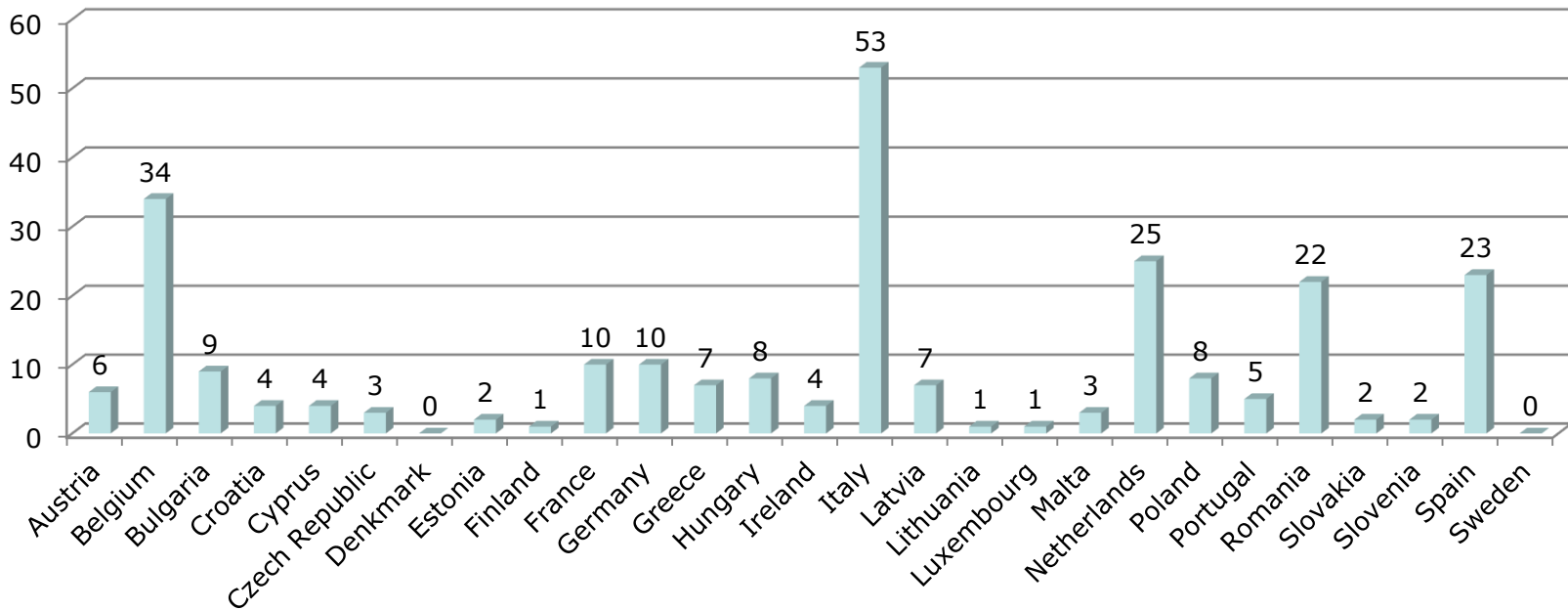
# Statistics on Cyprus' participation 2014

## II.a. European judicial training The EU framework (1)

- *Communication "A Europe of results – applying Community law" (COM(2007) 502)*
  - **1.3. Training in Community law**

**The good application of Community law depends on national authorities taking correct decisions. The Commission will ask Member States to confirm the availability of initial and life-long training in Community law for [civil servants and] judges, with a view to identifying supplementary training that the EU could support beyond existing actions in criminal, civil, commercial, competition and environmental law."**

## II.a. European judicial training The EU framework (2)

- *Communication "Building trust in EU-wide justice – a new dimension to European judicial training" (COM(2011) 551)*
  - **"Development of Union law must be coupled with effective implementation, which guarantees legal security and uniform interpretation. To train judges and legal practitioners in Union law is one of the key recommendations of Mario Monti's report to empower citizens and businesses to stand up for their rights and to ensure the effectiveness of the Single Market".**

## II.b. European judicial training policy (1)

- *Training of legal practitioners in EU law*
- *Objectives:*
  - **Correct and coherent implementation of EU law in the European Union**
  - **Mutual trust between legal practitioners in cross-border judicial proceedings**



## II.b. European judicial training policy (2)

- *"Legal practitioners"*
  - **Judges, prosecutors, court staff, bailiffs**
  - **Lawyers, notaries, mediators, legal interpreters and translators**
- *"EU law"*
  - **EU legislation and case-law**
  - **National law implementing EU directives**
  - **Legal systems of other Member States**

## **II.c. Sharing of competences**

### **A national responsibility**

- *Training of legal practitioners:  
a national competence*
  - **Training of judges and prosecutors: national judicial training entity (school, academy, supreme court, ministry department, etc.)**
  - **Training of court staff: ministries and courts**
  - **Training of self-organised professions like lawyers, notaries and some bailiffs: the professions and/or the private sector**

## **II.b. Sharing of competences**

### **A European support competence**

- *Article 17 TEU: European Commission as guardian of the treaties*
- *Articles 81.2.h and 82.1.c TFEU: specific European judicial training competences to support judicial cooperation in civil and criminal matters*

## II.d. EU-level support actions

- *Horizontal support and advice:*
  - **European judicial training team in DG Justice**
- *European e-Justice Portal:*
  - **Directory of training networks and providers**
  - **Training material for self-learning of legal practitioners and for trainers, including e-learning**
  - **Repository of best training practices for trainers**
  - **In future: European training platform**

## II.d. EU-level support actions

- *Financial support*
  - **Procurement:**  
**Creation of training modules on specific legislation and available for re-use by national trainers**  
**DG Environment, DG Justice (family law)**
  - **Action grants for cross-border training:**  
**DG Justice (civil justice, criminal justice, fundamental rights)**  
**DG Competition (competition law)**  
**OLAF (fight against fraud)**
  - **Organisation of training by some agencies (patent, asylum, etc.)**

Read carefully the call!

- Is your organisation **eligible** to apply?
- Does your project idea address the **priorities**?
- Do you have the minimum **partnership**? Is your proposed partnership appropriate for implementing your project?

## **III. How to submit an application (2)**

### **Preparation**

Read carefully the Award Criteria and their points!

- Relevance;
- Quality;
- European added value;
- Expected results, dissemination, sustainability and long-term impact;
- Cost effectiveness.

## III. How to submit an application (3) Preparation

- Start preparing the Annexes!
- Consult your **partners!**
- Read the **Guide** for Action Grants!
- Address any questions to the **Commission's mailbox!**

- Grant Application Form
- Annexes 1-14: Documents demonstrating your eligibility, operational capacity and financial capacity

## III. How to submit an application – DG COMP(3)

### Basic differences to DG JUST

- ⇒ No electronic submission: **application must be sent by post**
- ⇒ Small national grants possible (lowest 10.000)
- ⇒ Higher co-financing rate for some countries  
Co-financing **up to 80% and in exceptional and duly justified cases<sup>1</sup> up to 90%** of the total eligible costs of the projects.

<sup>1</sup>E.g. Applicants originating from EU Member States under financial assistance or surveillance (**Cyprus**, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Latvia, Portugal, Romania and Spain).

# III. How to submit an application – DG COMP(4)

## Basic differences to DG JUST

⇒ One call per year

⇒ Very concrete topic and target group

- Measures promoting **training in EU competition law** for national judges and **cooperation** between them (organisation of conferences, short or long-term training, the distribution of documentation and information on EU competition law specifically tailored to the needs of national judges etc.)
- Target audience:
  - **"Judicial staff"** (i.e. Judges, Prosecutors, Judicial court staff, Bailiffs, Notaries, Mediators)
  - One or several professions
  - Participants from one or several Member States

## IV. What makes a good project? (1)

### Relevance

- ✓ **Relevant**, in line with priorities
- ✓ Addresses a **specific & real need** in the field
- ✓ Addresses the **appropriate audience/target group**
- ✓ Clear concept, well explained **objectives**
- ✓ Mainstreaming, where relevant

## IV. What makes a good project? (2)

### Results

- ✓ Achieves relevant **results**
- ✓ **Involves the target groups**
- ✓ Produces **sustainable** results
- ✓ Realistic/quantifiable **outputs**
- ✓ Good **dissemination**



## IV. What makes a good project? (2)

### Methodology

- ✓ Attainable **activities**, appropriate to meet the objectives
- ✓ **Well planned** activities, elaborated in **sufficient detail** (workstreams)
- ✓ Well established **methodology**
- ✓ **Monitoring** of implementation
- ✓ Identification of **risks** & mitigating measures

## IV. What makes a good project? (3)

Strong **partnership**

- partner organisations
- employees

Strong **EU dimension, EU added value**

To be demonstrated also for national projects!

**Cost-effective** project, well planned **budget**
